| School Drop By Visits | Drive to local school sites and drop off popcorn packets to say, "Just Popping In". Attached to popcorn is information about S&Y programs and LLS Patient Services. Mileage reimbursement available. | must have transportation, good with directions, personable | September - November | |
| School & Youth Ambassador | Help make connections into schools, identify prospective schools & contacts at schools to run the S&Y Program. Ex. Know parents in school PTA, recruit a parent to run program at their child's school & connection to leadership group at school or connection to community civic groups that work with students. ex. Kiwanis, Rotary Club, etc. | perseverance and not afraid to ask | September - March | Yes |
| Assembly Presentations | Lead a school assembly. Follow script and carry out presentation with excitement and motivation. This is a chance to educate and build awareness about blood cancer and the School & Youth programs to an entire student body. | Public speaking, good communication skills, motivating & engaging | December - June | |
| School & Youth Mentor | Serve as a resource for a new coordinator. Help them come up with ideas, motivate them and help them with any problems during their program. | Past or current coordinator that has a strong connection to the program or LLS mission | December - June | Yes |
| Thank You Calls/Best of luck Calls | Contact registered schools to thank them for signing up and to wish them luck on their program. Usually will call the coordinator and Principal at the school | Either survivor or loved one of a patient | January - June | Yes |
| School Co-Coordinator | Help a local school in your area to run a School & Youth Program | motivation to support LLS, works well with others | January - June | Yes |

| Packing Materials | Help with packing program materials for schools | attention to detail, organized & can lift 20 lbs if necessary | November - March | |
| Phone Planning Meetings | Call school coordinators over the phone and walk them through the program and share best practices. Answer questions and also gather information about their program. (30 min calls) | Good phone skills, communication skills, punctual, customer service & good listening skills | December - June | Yes |
| Group Planning Meetings | Lead group planning meetings at school sites. Usually with student leadership groups. Follow meeting agenda, motivate students, present best practices, and help them develop a plan for their School & Youth Program. (30 min meetings) | Public speaking & communication skills | December - June | |

| Administrative | Filing, data entry, web research, mailings, post program on volunteer websites | Attention to detail, good written/communication skills & computer skills | Year Round | Yes |
